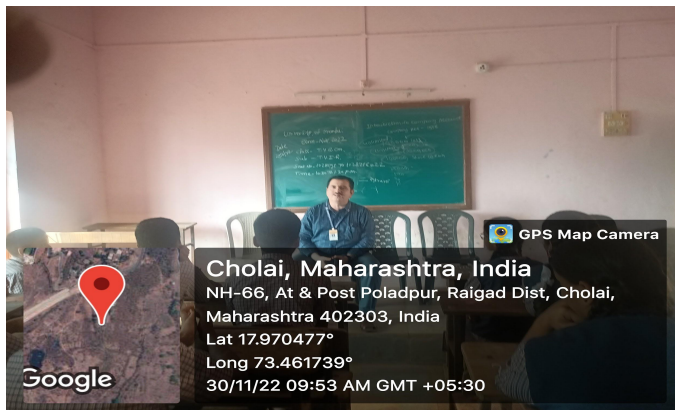


Blood donation camp held on the occasion of founder of the College Late Prabhakarji More's birth anniversary
