

Constitution Day celebrated with enthusiasm in Sundarrao More College

At the beginning of this program organized by the National Service Scheme Department of the college, Bharat Ratna Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar, architect of the Indian Constitution was worshipped and garlanded. Program Officer of National Service Schemes Department, Prof. Dr. Ram Barkule, presented the introduction at the beginning of the program, followed by a mass reading of the Preamble of the Constitution. Speaking on this occasion, Vice Principal Prof. Sunil Balkhande expressed his opinion that history is not only battles and wars but also the study of the social, economic and political conditions of the society in each period and expressed the opinion that the young generation should study the social, economic and political conditions of the society in different periods. Prof. Manoj Bhagat, Assistant Professor in the English Department of the college, while speaking as the keynote speaker, gave a scholarly speech on the topic of Fundamental Rights and Duties in the Constitution of India. At the beginning of his lecture, Prof. Manoj Bhagat gave detailed information to the students about the nature of the Constitution of India, its various parts, sub-sections and clauses. Prof. Manoj Bhagat made a thoughtful comment on how the basic rights

given to the common man in India are taken away by the state or are hesitated to be protected through the judiciary. He informed the audience about the important contribution of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar in the creation of the Constitution of India and how the role of the Indian Constitution is important in protecting unity in diversity and parliamentary democracy in India. Every person in India is a direct and indirect beneficiary of the provisions of the Indian Constitution, unfortunately, as there is still not enough awareness among the masses, Prof. Manoj Bhagat expressed the opinion that there is a need to create more public awareness about the importance and requirements of the Constitution. In his presidential address, the principal of the college, Dr. Deepak Raverkar, expressed the need for the college youth to take initiative in fulfilling the rights given by the Indian Constitution as well as the duties mentioned in the same constitution.
